

Bridgewater Township Work Session

Official Minutes

Call to order at 1:00 pm

Roll Call: John Holden, Glen Castore, Gary Ebling, Frances Boehning, Brent Aspenwall

- County Road 1 reconstruction.
 - A discussion was held regarding the current status of the Cty Rd 1 reconstruction project and the impact on 115th street.

- Storm Damage Clean Up in developments
 - A review of the costs to date was discussed. Future estimates will need to include Gleason and Perry Collins.
 - As much of the clean has been completed, township residents will be notified that the township will stop pick up the evening of 10/23. A final round will be made by Aspenwall Tree Service following this to clean up any remaining debris.
 - John Holden will go through the developments and determine how many stumps are in the right of way that needs to be removed. Gleason will remove the stumps.
 - An estimate will be needed to determine the cost of clearing the remaining right of way.
 - When final costs are known, a discussion will be held regarding assessing the developments.
 - Per Brent Aspenwall, about 10% of the tree debris picked up in Upper Oak Hills was the responsibility of the township. The number of loads pickup up per lot was reviewed by Brent.
 - Aspenwall felt that all debris picked up in Lower Oak Hills was the responsibility of the township.
 - A short discussion was held regarding how to layout the information that will be submitted to the state.

- Remaining Storm Damage Clean Up
 - A discussion was held regarding the other areas of the township that will need to have storm damage removed.
 - 132nd Street – about 4 days worth of work
 - 125th Street – about 5 days plus extra to remove hanging trees. Approximately 15 days total. Cost is usually \$5,000 to \$7,500 per day.
 - Brent Aspenwall will clean up stuff already down and Perry Collins will remove any standing trees in the right of way.
 - Per Brent Aspenwall, there are about 2 days left to clean up the developments.
 - Brent felt the estimated total to date was about \$170,000 with an additional \$168,000 to complete.
 - An invoice will be submitted at Aspenwall Tree Service for services to date.
 - Glen Castore made a motion to pay the invoice from Aspenwall not to exceed \$190,000, John Holden seconded, all approved.
